5 Major Indications for Rapid Referral:

Check box & fax back form if your patient meets these criteria for fast tracking

1. Severe Chronic Urticaria ☐

- **Rapid Referral Criteria:** **Hives despite quadruple-dose antihistamine**
✓ Consider a trial of *Blexten* 80 mg/day, *Cetirizine/Reactine* 40 mg/day, or *Rupall* 40 mg/day for fast-tracking (FYI: adult dosing)

2. Severe Eczema/Atopic Dermatitis ☐

- **Rapid Referral Criteria:** **Refractory/relapsing eczema despite mid-high potency topical steroids and/or course(s) of prednisone**

3. Severe Asthma ☐

- **Rapid Referral Criteria:** **Uncontrolled asthma with exacerbations requiring prednisone despite high-dose ICS/LABA +/- LAMA**
✓ Consider a trial of one of these robust inhalers for fast tracking:
 - *Atecura* 150/320 mcg 1 puff daily, *Breo* 200/25 mcg 1 puff daily, *Zenhale* 200/5 mcg 2 puffs bid, *Symbicort* 200/6 mcg 2 puffs bid +prn up 8 puffs/day, *Enerzair* 150/50/160 mcg 1 puff daily, *Trelegy* 200/25/62.5 mcg 1 puff daily
✓ Attach CBC, Total IgE, CXR if available

4. Severe Chronic Rhinosinusitis/Nasal Polyps ☐

- **Rapid Referral Criteria:** **Severe Congestion & Smell Loss despite nasal steroids & montelukast as well as prior sinus surgery and/or systemic corticosteroids (e.g., prednisone 30 mg/day x 10 days) in the last 12 months**
✓ Consider a trial of *Prednisone* 30 mg/day x 10 days for fast-tracking

5. Severe Eosinophilic Esophagitis (EoE) ☐

- **Rapid Referral Criteria:** **Dysphagia despite high dose PPI (e.g., Pantoloc 40 mg bid, Dexilant 60 mg/day), Swallowed Steroids (e.g., Jorveza 1 mg PO bid; Flovent 250 mcg 2 puffs bid swallowed)**
